(Drums) Drum any way you want to...



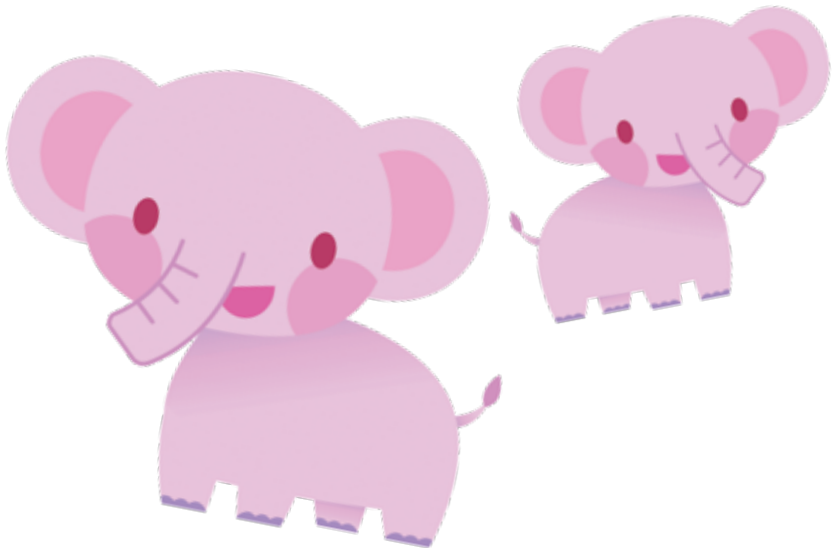
Willaby Wallaby Woo

(wrap your arms and shiver)

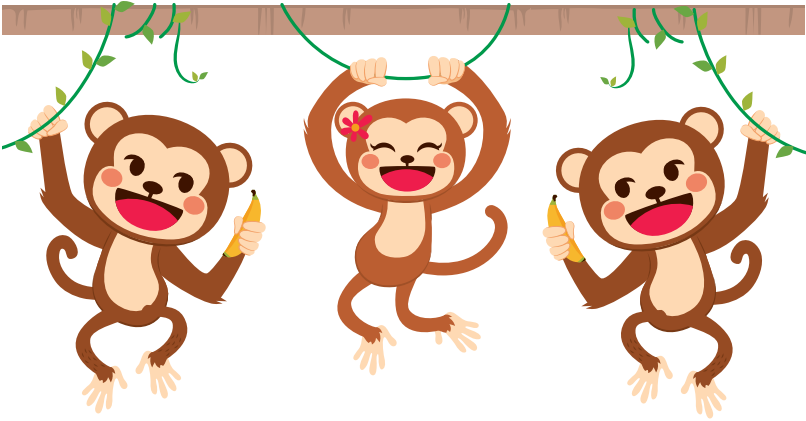
Now there are 2 green speckled frogs.
