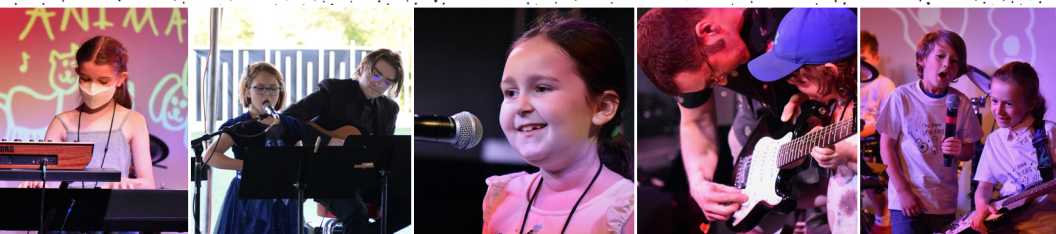

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2022: TENTH ANNIVERSARY

LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



2022 IN REVIEW

.....

What a tenth anniversary year it was here at Youth Music Project (YMP)! Our enrollment grew 32% over the previous year as programs began rocking and rolling in-person once again! Our quarterly student concert weeks and monthly teen open mic nights joyously returned to our incredible Meteor Lounge, and we were so happy to celebrate in-person once again with so many supporters at our annual benefit auction and concert!

Most importantly, we formed new relationships and sustained existing ones as we fulfilled our mission to teach rock, pop, and country music to 1,280 non-duplicated students (and over 9,000 teaching hours!) regardless of their family's ability to pay, with 34% of our enrollments provided at no cost.

Just like learning a new instrument, it wasn't always easy. 2022 brought with it plenty of changes and transitions, too. We were not immune from the staffing transitions many organizations experienced during this historically tumultuous time. This turnover had meaningful impacts: recruitment and training require a lot of time, energy, and resources, while maintaining the high-quality operations and experiences our families are accustomed to. While a challenging year in this regard, relationships are the lifeblood of our success, and we are committed as ever to being a resilient and resourceful staff providing exceptional musical experiences to our kids and families, aspiring to and modeling the same lessons we teach in our classrooms – that of practice, patience, and persistence.

None of this would have been achievable without our committed band of supporters, (in other words, you!) who make it possible for us to continue to deliver on our mission to provide youth of all ages and backgrounds accessible, high-quality music education and performance opportunities and all the many social and emotional benefits these experiences provide. The families, donors, grant funders, sponsors, board members, and community leaders who support and advocate for YMP and our students truly make this magical place possible. Simply put: thank you!

As we look ahead to the future of YMP, the horizon looks bright and the sounds of children making music and memories scores the action. Every term we are reaching for new ways to connect with more students, teach more classes, and help our kiddos grow. Thank you for being an integral part of our YMP family. Modeled by our YMP board, staff and leadership, YMP uses the study of music to empower students to appreciate and respect differences, encourage critical thinking, listen deeply, and make space for and include all voices and perspectives.

As we continue our journey of equity and inclusion, we are focused on the following goals:

Practice is at the heart of mastery, and a core tenet of music education. The YMP team recognizes that we must constantly practice in order to achieve our goals. In practice – we learn from our mistakes, we encourage each other to be vulnerable, we hold each other accountable, we support, we teach, we step up to the mic when it's our turn, and step back when it's time for someone else to sing. We know that our efforts and our attitudes affect everyone around us.

A chord in music is the sounding of two or more notes at the same time. Equity and our work toward change is, essentially, the harmonization of a chord. **We recognize that we will always have opportunities to include more notes and different perspectives at YMP, and we are committed to welcome, create, and celebrate this rich harmony that makes our song whole.**

FIELD TRIPS

After taking a two year-hiatus, we were thrilled to bring back school field trips to the building! Students received first hand experience with instruments and even learned a song (or two!) We can't wait to see more smiling school kids (and grown-ups—we do workplace team bonding too!) in 2023.

TEEN OPEN MIC

Our Teen Interns re-booted Open Mic nights in March and have been rocking right along ever since. We've seen crowds of over a hundred people fill the Meteor Lounge to support our community of talented young artists.

BENEFIT AUCTION

YMP welcomed back our friends and supporters to the building for our annual fundraising benefit! The events theme was (appropriately) “Back to School Night” and the evening was a tremendous success, grossing \$130K for tuition assistance.

MUSIC CREATES...

2022 was our first year of inclusion in *Willamette Week's* Give!Guide alongside 200+ other local nonprofits. Give!Guide is the Portland metro area's easiest pathway to end-of-year giving, and through it you helped us raised nearly \$40K for our students. The campaign focused on the feelings and opportunities that music creates for our students, including **creativity, confidence, and resilience.**

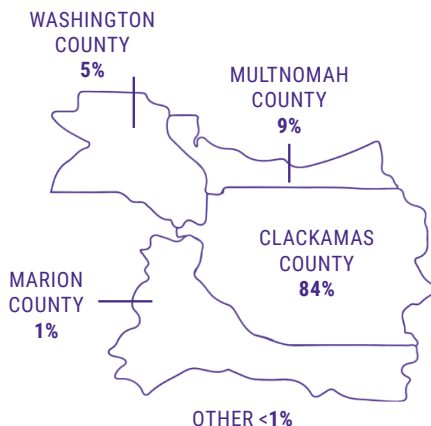

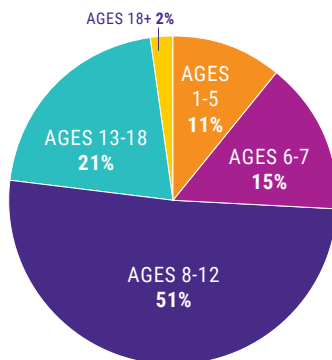

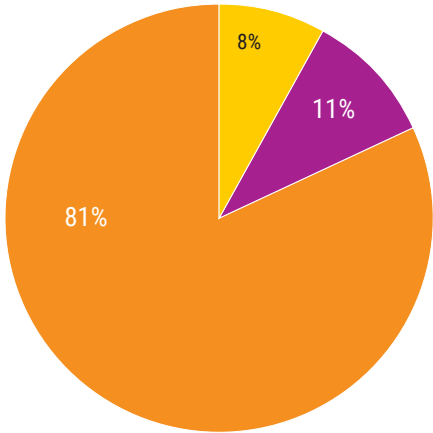

FINANCIALS

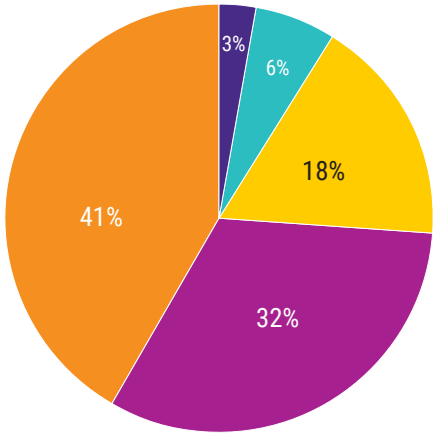
Youth Music Project believes that music education should be affordable and accessible to all youth. In 2022, we provided music education to 1,280 non-duplicated students through 2,705 enrollments. 914 (34%) of enrollments were tuition free, with the remaining 66% subsidized by direct public support.

2022 also marked ten years of our paid YMP Internship program, with over 61 graduates having completed placements with us. We have had interns from all over the Portland Metro area, with some continuing on as instructors in our program and many continuing to study music and teaching in their college years. We typically employ 8-12 interns at a time, for a two year period, and intentionally keep the program small to encourage camaraderie and peer to peer support amongst each cohort.

2022 Intern **MarleyJo** says, "Being an intern here has helped me experience the pure excitement kids get when they finally strum their first string, or play their first chord. I got encouraged to learn new instruments myself. **It has made me grow as a person and it's helped me finally achieve my goal of making music with new friends and peers.** YMP is definitely a positive and wonderful environment."
